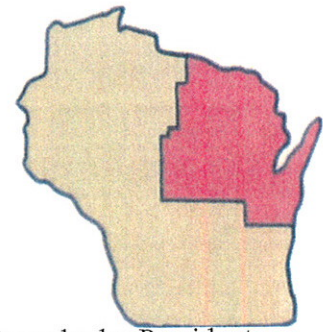

The program continued @ 12:45Pm with coverage of construction joints and protection of ductwork (plenum & grease ducts). The program concluded at 1:40PM. President Mike Miller called the business meeting to order @ 1:45PM. The August 2008 minutes where approved as published. Secretary, Jon Oldenburg, gave a Treasurers' report to the group which was also approved.

Leroy Stublaski, Wisconsin Department of Commerce, reported to the group that a required meeting for any inspection agencies wishing to bid on contracts with the Department will be held in Wausau. Further information on this meeting is available on the Department of Commerce website.

Vice President Dennis Jensen reported to the group that the October 02 2008 meeting will be a tour of the Forest Products Laboratory test ting facility in Madison Wisconsin, and will include the research demonstration house and the engineering mechanics and remote sensing lab. Pick up will be at 7:15 a.m. at the De Pere Community center located at 600 Grant St. in De Pere. The coach bus will make a stop at the Holiday Inn off Highway 41/ 151 in Fond Du Lac at app. 8:30 a.m. The tour of the facility will begin at 10:00 am and end at about 12:00 p.m. The bus will leave Madison at 1:00 pm. Jack Van Der Weele reported to the group that the annual Winter Code Updates UDC session will be opened to include Dwelling Contractors. The Rock Gardens facilities can accommodate up to 400-persons total when using both rooms. He has conferred with the Department of Commence and it has been decided to cap the attendance at 300-total which would allow for an additional 94-persons over last years attendance.

This was approved by the group.

A round table session was held. The meeting was adjourned @ 2:15PM.
