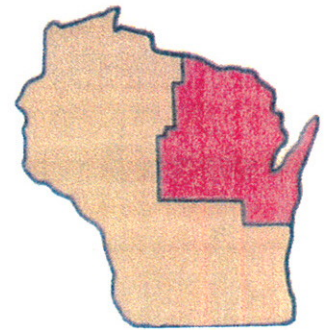

Dave Raymond, City of Kaukauna, reported that the League of Municipalities will be forwarding a resolution to the State recommending that the State adopt the International Residential Building Code. This is in follow up to a vote held at the League Inspectors Institute which supported this action. A task force of four representatives from the Builder's Association and six representatives from the individual Building Inspector Associations will examine the International Code in relation to the current Wisconsin U.D.C. to determine any problems or deficiencies that may be encountered in a change over. This task force is to be completed before Wisconsin Department of Commerce begins it's evaluation of the International Residential Code so that its findings may be submitted in advance of the States evaluation.

AN ORGANIZATION OF INSPECTIONS OFFICIALS FROM TWENTY-ONE WISCONSIN COUNTIES

Brown, Calumet, Door, Florence, Forest, Kewaunee, Langlade, Lincoln, Manitowoc, Marinette, Marathon, Menominee, Oconto, Oneida, Outagamie, Portage, Shawano, Waupaca, Winnebago, Wood, and Vitas

Ray Weber, Wisconsin Department of Commerce Electrical Inspection, announced that the registration of all contractors is effective on June 01, 2009. He also announced that as of March 01 2010 all municipalities must provide for commercial electrical inspections. The municipalities must register with Department of Commerce as a Registered Electrical Inspection Agency. Communities not registering will have the responsibility of providing the commercial electrical inspections to their perspective county. It is anticipated that most counties will bid this work out to a private registered agency.

Ray also announced that as of April 01, 2013 all people doing electrical work will be required to be licensed with the state.
